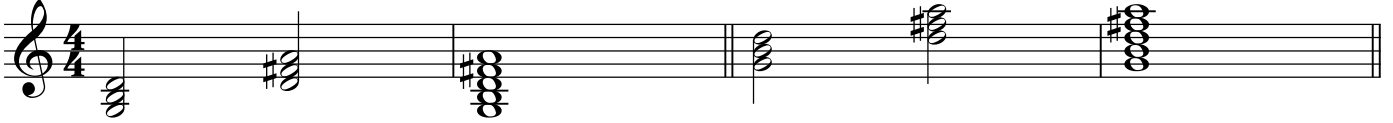


# What's A Nine ?

G Major + D Major = G Major 7th (9)



C Major + G Major = C Major 7th (9)



G Minor + D Minor = G Minor 7th (9)



C Minor + G Minor = C Minor 7th (9)



A good way to practice this concept is to play the root of your target chord ie C and the play a G major or minor triad which will give you the thought process of learning perfect 5ths. Do this in every key and soon you will be able to use them on the gig .

Remember the extension of of ninth can be used on other chord qualities not just major and minor chords and our homework is to figure out what do you call a minor triad played over a major triad in this fashion . Bye all
